CLOTHING ARRANGEMENTS

1. GRAND OFFICERS will clothe in the Past Grand Officers' Room and sign the Attendance Sheets. Those Grand Officers whose intention to be present is notified to the Provincial Grand Scribe E by 14 October 2019 will form the first procession, those Grand Officers who have not so notified should take their seat in the Grand Temple before the entry of the procession.

Entrance: Main Admin. Entrance, Great Queen Street.

2. PRESENT ACTING PROVINCIAL GRAND OFFICERS will clothe in the Past Grand Officers' Room, sign the Attendance Sheets, and will form the fourth Procession into Provincial Grand Chapter. COMPANIONS TO BE APPOINTED AND PROMOTED will clothe in the Past Grand Officers' Room, and they will sign the Attendance Sheets and take their numbered seats in the Temple. PAST PROVINCIAL GRAND OFFICERS will clothe in the Past Grand Officers' Room, sign the Attendance Sheets and take their seats in the Temple.

Entrance: Main Admin. Entrance, Great Queen Street.

3. PRINCIPALS will clothe in the ground floor rooms adjacent to the Wild Street entrance, sign the Attendance Sheets in the vestibule upstairs appropriate to their Chapter, and wait to form the second Procession into Provincial Grand Chapter.

PAST PRINCIPALS AND COMPANIONS will clothe in the ground floor rooms. They will sign the Attendance Sheets appropriate to their Chapter in the vestibule upstairs and take their places in the Temple.

Entrance: Grand Temple Entrance at the junction of Great Queen Street and Wild Street (under the tower).
